



it merges and integrates itself within each new living space and within its social environment.




Habitaculum

Immersion in a mutual language

The *Kamchàtka* language is based on feelings, crossing lingual borders towards universal communication. Its aim is **to convert the simple and the essential into stimulus for an invaluable human co-operative relationship**, stirring up a human encounter which goes beyond culture and social status.



HOSTING HABITACULUM FOR A CREATIVE RESIDENCY

We wish to research and show that any group of people who reach a new country, a new habitat, also bring along new customs and experiences which in our case would be represented by the unique language already developed by KAMCHATKA.

Yet this time, it is within a household which has been especially transformed so it can invite the public to visit and share a unique and enriching way of life.

This idea comes from the mere reality that no matter which country they are in, within their own home, their own "Habitaculum", new immigrants maintain and follow life based on their own traditions, incorporating at times the local with the strange and distant; but more than anything else, they seek to find a place within society and culture where they feel comfortable and welcome and where they feel integrated and can form social ties.


WHAT WE NEED...


