

Post Doctoral Research Associate

The Center for Research in International Economics (CREI), invites applications for a Post Doctoral Research Associate in International Economics and Institutions (Note: this is not a regular CREI tenure-track position, which is advertised separately)

Post Doctoral Research Associates are expected to work on the project "Institutions and Globalization," financed by the European Research Council (ERC) in collaboration with Nicola Gennaioli (the principal investigator) and Alberto Martin. The Post Doctoral Research Associate position also provides opportunities for independent research as well as for interactions with the academic community of CREI and Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF). Appointment will be for one academic year with possibility for renewal given satisfactory performance (up to four years). Applicants should include resume, two letters of recommendation and one or at most two research papers.

CREI is a research institute sponsored by the Government of Catalonia and Universitat Pompeu Fabra with the aim of promoting economic research subject to the highest standards. It is located in Barcelona, within the campus of UPF.
